

Natural rubber [production](#) decreased by 11.8 per cent in November 2022 (28,048 tonnes) as compared to October 2022 (31,795 tonnes). Year-on-year comparison also showed that the [production](#) of natural rubber decreased by 8.0 per cent (November 2021: 30,493 tonnes). [Production](#) of natural rubber in November 2022 for Malaysia was mainly contributed by smallholders sector (87.2%) as compared to estates sector (12.8%).

Total [stocks](#) of natural rubber in November 2022 decreased by 1.4 per cent to 195,353 tonnes as compared to 198,181 tonnes in October 2022. Rubber processors factory contributed 90.4 per cent of the [stocks](#) followed by rubber consumers factory (9.5%) and rubber estates (0.1%).

[Exports](#) of Malaysia's natural rubber amounted to 51,104 tonnes in November 2022, increased 23.0 per cent as against October 2022 (41,548 tonnes). P.R. China remained as the main destination for natural rubber [exports](#) which accounted 54.3 per cent of total [exports](#) in November 2022 followed by the United States of America (3.6%), Germany (2.8%), Turkiye (2.2%) and Brazil (1.8%).

Analysis of the average monthly [price](#) showed that Latex Concentrated recorded an increase of 1.3 per cent (November 2022: 472.58 sen per kg, October 2022: 466.42 sen per kg) while, Scrap decreased by 5.9 per cent (November 2022: 443.36 sen per kg, October 2022: 471.29 sen per kg). Prices for all Standard Malaysian Rubber (S.M.R) are mixed with a decline of 3.8 per cent and increase up to 1.3 per cent.
