MONTHLY RUBBER STATISTICS MALAYSIA, MARCH 2016

Natural Rubber (NR) production increased by 5.7% in March 2016

In March 2016, production of NR registered **57,678** tonnes with an increase of **5.7** per cent as compared to February 2016. The main contributor of NR production is from smallholding sector with more than **90** per cent.

Average monthly price of latex concentrate was **408.52** sen per kilogramme, increased by **52.94** sen per kilogramme as compared to February 2016. Meanwhile, S.M.R.20 recorded at **516.98** sen per kilogramme, went up by **62.95** sen per kilogramme as compared to previous month.

Exports of Malaysian NR increased to **53,587** tonnes as compared to February 2016. Nevertheless, the exports reduced by **12.4** per cent as compared to March 2015. The five main destinations of NR exports were China followed by Germany, Iran, U.S.A. and Finland.

Domestic consumption of NR in March 2016 recorded at **41,786** tonnes, increased by **7.4** per cent as compared to February 2016. Year-on-year comparison also showed an increase of **9.0** per cent. Rubber gloves industry recorded more than **50** per cent of NR consumption from the total domestic consumption.

The level of NR stocks held at the end of March 2016 rose by **0.9** per cent to **239,969** tonnes when compared to the previous month. Rubber Processors is the largest NR stocks holder.




Exports





Chart 1: Monthly production, exports, imports, domestic consumption and stocks of natural rubber 2015/2016
