MONTHLY RUBBER STATISTICS MALAYSIA, MARCH 2017

Natural Rubber (NR) decreased by 7.4 per cent in March 2017

Production of NR in March 2017 decreased by **7.4** per cent to **79,966** tonnes as compared to previous month. The main contributor of NR production is from smallholding sector which is more than **90** per cent.

Average monthly price of Latex Concentrate and Standard Malaysian Rubber 20 were **731.80** sen per kilogramme and **863.07** sen per kilogramme, decreased by **8.3** per cent and **10.7** per cent respectively from February 2017.

In March 2017, exports of NR increased by **2.7** per cent to **59,520** tonnes as compared to February 2017. Five main destinations of NR exports were China, Germany, Iran, Finland and Turkey.

In the meantime, domestic consumption of NR increased by **15.0** per cent to **41,727** tonnes within the same period. Rubber gloves industry remains as the main domestic consumer of over **70** per cent.

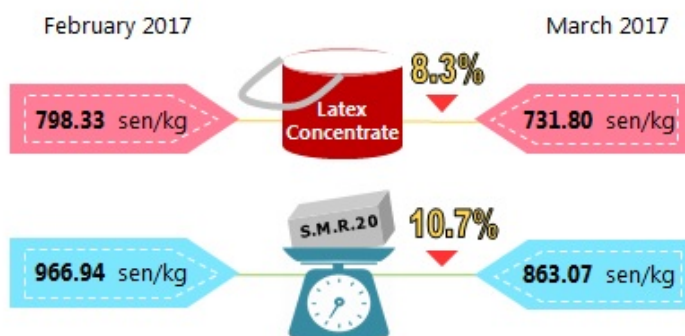
At the end of March 2017, level of NR stocks went up by **4.1** per cent to **256,692** tonnes.

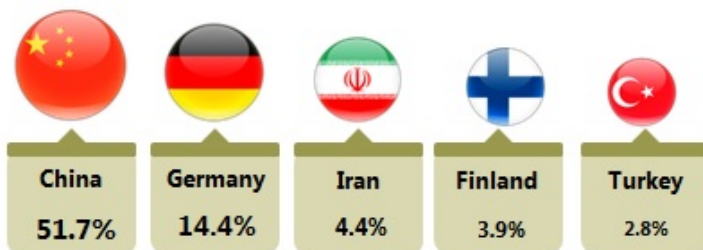

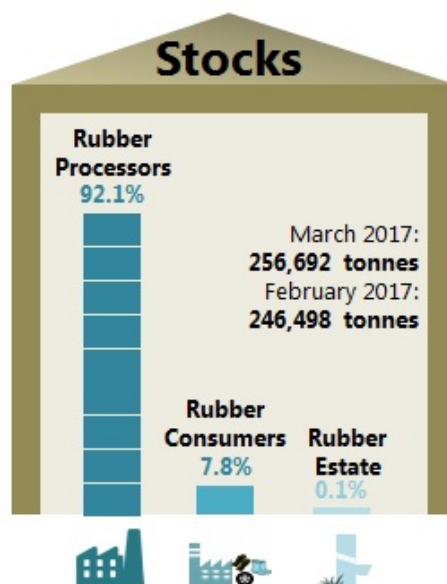
Exports

Exports of NR increased by 2.7% as compared to February 2017. The main destination of NR exports was China.

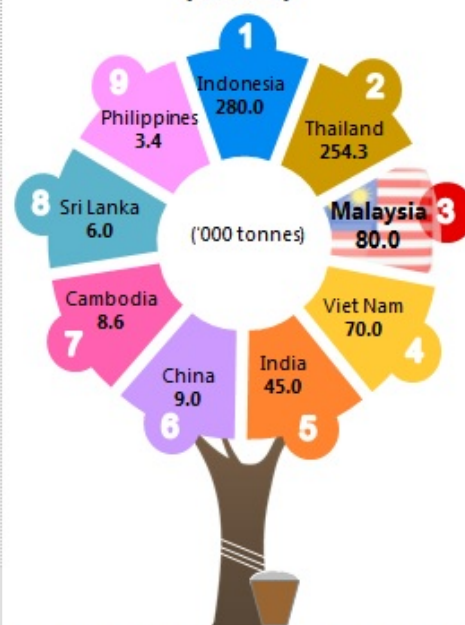

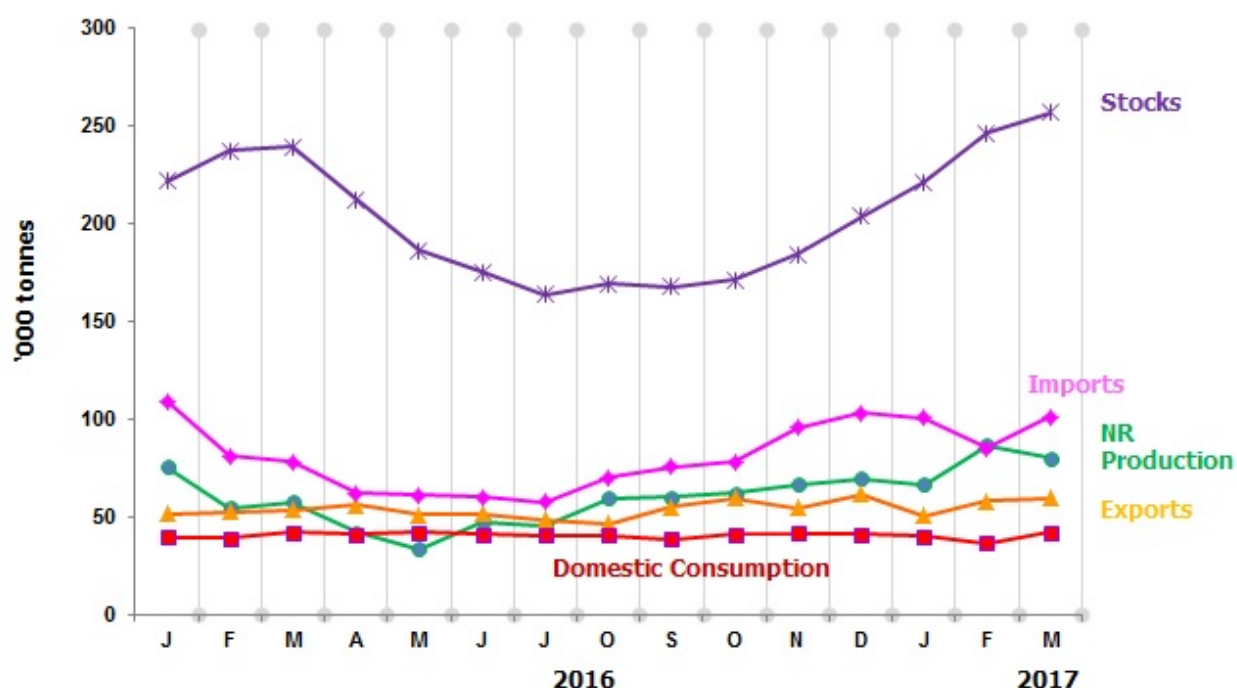
