

THE CHIEF STATISTICIAN MALAYSIA'S MESSAGE



All praises and thanks to Allah SWT for the success in publishing the **Department of Statistics, Malaysia 70-Years Producer of National Statistics** book. Congratulations to all DOSM members who involve in the publication of this book in conjunction with the 70th anniversary of the Department of Statistics, Malaysia.

This publication is dedicated to honour and reward all the hard work and contributions of DOSM community, including former department officials who have greatly manifested their minds to uphold the glory of DOSM. In the early '60s, in line with the developments during that particular time, DOSM released data on foreign trade and agriculture. As time goes by, DOSM continues to move forward by providing other data covering a wide range of economic and social in an effort to collect, interpret and disseminate key statistics for national socio-economic planning and monitoring. In order to meet the users' demands, DOSM has also released data until to the micro level for more detailed analysis purposes.

By inheriting a strong statistical system from the past leaders and officials, it enabled DOSM to carve out more success. One of it was the 62nd ISI World Statistics Congress 2019 which was attended by 2,500 delegates from all over the world. Thus, DOSM became one of the statistical agencies that is on an equal footing with other advanced international statistical agencies.

In terms of statistical products, among the latest statistics published by DOSM were Quarterly Labour Productivity, Graduates Statistics, Marriage and Divorce Statistics Malaysia, Children Statistics Malaysia, Malaysia Digital Economy, Tourism Satellite Account, Information and Communication Technology Satellite Account and Malaysian Well-Being Index Report. DOSM has also developed data visualisations including MyLocal Stats and BizCode@Stats mobile applications, Malaysia Business Cycle Clock (MBCC) and Malaysia CPI Inflation Calculator.

DOSM continues to expand and improve the National Enterprise Wide Statistical System by developing eQIS (Quality Improvement Survey), MyStatsACE and eGlossary TK. DOSM also introduced the Analytics BootCamp session for the first time. Statistics Data Warehouse (StatsDW) has also been improved with the introduction of eDataBank, Visualisation and Time Series modules, as well as Location Intelligence, StatsDW MyLab and StatsDW Analytics. DOSM also developed the Digitalisation of DOSM Publication Laboratory, known as StatsDigital. In terms of big data analytics, DOSM has developed the STATS BigData Analytics (STATSBDA) project which covers three key elements namely structured data, unstructured data and sentiment analysis. As the outcome of these initiatives, the Trade by Enterprise Characteristic (TEC), Price Intelligence (PI) and Public Maturity Assessment on Official Statistics (PMAOS), Real Time News on Official Statistics (RTOS) and Real Time Business Status (RTBS) initiatives have also been developed.

Malaysia's role in statistics has also expanded. DOSM was appointed as the Chairman for Members of the Bureau, Organization of Islamic Corporation Statistical Commission (OIC-StatCom), Chairman of the Committee on Statistics of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP) and Co-chair Working Group (WG) on the Development of New Strategic Vision of OIC-StatCom. Recently, DOSM was also appointed as the Panel of Expert for the UN Human Development Index (HDI) and the Panel of Expert Group for the Inter Agency and Expert Group on Sustainable Development Goal Indicators (IAEG-SDGs). This reflects the confidence of the international statistical community to continue giving their trust towards DOSM in performing statistical leadership functions.

DOSM used various communication mediums in disseminating the national official statistics for general public to get information easily. These include releasing publications through hardcopy and free download via e-Statistics which is available on the DOSM portal, using social media such as Facebook (Department of Statistics, Malaysia), Twitter (StatsMalaysia), Instagram (StatsMalaysia) and WhatsApp application.

The Department will continuously taking steps to improve the quality of existing services to meet the users' needs in current dynamic and challenging environment. DOSM will also continue to take initiatives from time to time in order to enhance DOSM's capability to confront the technological explosion of the Fourth Industrial Revolution and the Internet of Things. Recognising these challenges, DOSM has produced nine data scientists in 2018 and will continue to enhance the competencies of Department's officials in this area through comprehensive and structured courses and trainings.

Towards the end of 2019, coronavirus or officially known as COVID-19 hit the globe. In some way, the pandemic boosted the morale and commitment of DOSM community to become the frontliner in providing up-to-date statistics along with comprehensive narrative on the effects of COVID-19. The Government of Malaysia implemented Movement Control Order (MCO) to control the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic. Since the beginning of the MCO, DOSM has published various statistics such as newsletters, special bulletin and news coverage's summary on the impact of COVID-19 to the economy. DOSM also conducted special surveys related to this pandemic and provides business intelligence reports. New information disseminated by DOSM is hoped to benefit all parties to have better understanding on this scenario and take prompt action to reduce the challenges of the pandemic. The outbreak of the COVID-19 has opened the way for DOSM to increase public literacy in statistics. In this regard, DOSM introduced virtual press conference and announced a number of labour-focused statistics. To meet the latest data requirements, foreign trade statistics has been released earlier. In addition, the participation of DOSM community in online conferences has also become a new normal and this has opened up the opportunity for more Department members to participate in the international conferences.

Finally, I believe this book - Department of Statistics, Malaysia 70-Years Producer of National Statistics - will inspire all DOSM community to uphold and promote the DOSM not only in Malaysia but all over the world. Hopefully, all the hard works and commitments will be continued in the future.



External Trade Statistics was compiled by the Customs Department for the three regions known as Federated Malay States, Unfederated Malay States and the Straits Settlements. At that time, the Headquarters of the Customs Department was in Singapore. For the states in Borneo, external trade data was compiled by the British Government which was under the control of the Colony of North Borneo.

Post World War II

The Central Trade Registry was established with its Headquarters in Brickfields, Kuala Lumpur under the Customs Ordinance to compile data on external trade.

One section in the Department of Agriculture was established to collect data on production of crops in estate.

Year
1949



Under the Statistics Ordinance 1949, the Statistics Section in both the Central Trade Registry and Department of Agriculture were merged to become the Bureau of Statistics. The Bureau, headed by the Registrar of Statistics, was responsible for the collection. Preparation and publication of statistics were supported by the ordinance. One section in the Department of Agriculture was established to collect data on production of crops in estate.

A committee was appointed on 5 March 1960 by the Federal Government to consider and recommend the future development of statistical services in the Government. This committee was chaired by Y.M. Raja Tan Sri Mohar bin Raja Badiozaman. This was the first time that such a study was conducted and the recommendations of the committee formed the basis for the future development of statistical services.

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

The Statistics Act 1965 was passed by the Parliament and the Statistics Ordinance 1949 was repealed. Under this Act, the Bureau of Statistics was to be known as the Department of Statistics. The new act was more comprehensive and it further strengthened the authority of the Department to collect statistics.

The Bureau of Statistics Sarawak and the Department of Statistics, Sabah became branches of the Department of Statistics, Malaysia.

The Headquarters comprises 12 divisions as follows:

With the increased work load, RFCs were established in Kuala Lumpur, Georgetown and Ipoh to increase the efficiency in data collection in the states concerned.

RFCs were established in Kuantan, Johor Bahru and Kota Bharu. RFC Kuantan covered the major part of Pahang (except West Pahang) and part of Terengganu. RFC Johor Bahru covered Johor, Melaka and part of Negeri Sembilan while RFC Kota Bharu covered Kelantan and part of Terengganu.

The objectives outlined in the Second Corporate Plan 1993-1997 were implemented to enhance strategic management. Thus, the divisions in the Headquarters were restructured as follow:

- National Accounts Divisions was split into two divisions, National Accounts Divisions and Economic Indicators Divisions;
- Socio-Economic Development Division became Household Income and Expenditure Division and Manpower and Social Division;
- Demography Division was split into two divisions, Population and Housing Census Division and Demographic Division;
- External Trade and Balance of Payment Divisions was split into External Trade Division and Balance of Payments Division; and
- Industries and Services Division was split into Industries Division and Services Division.
