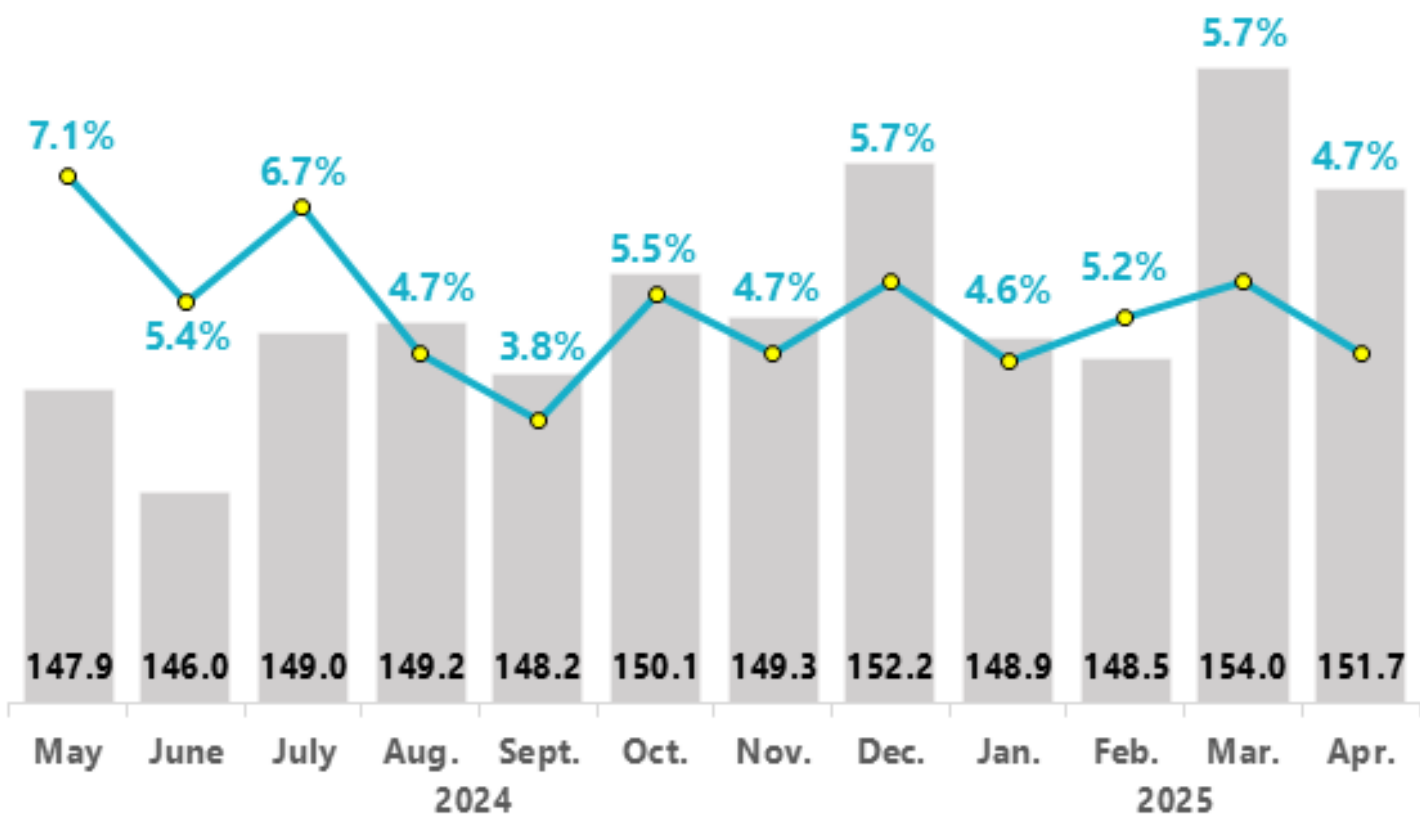


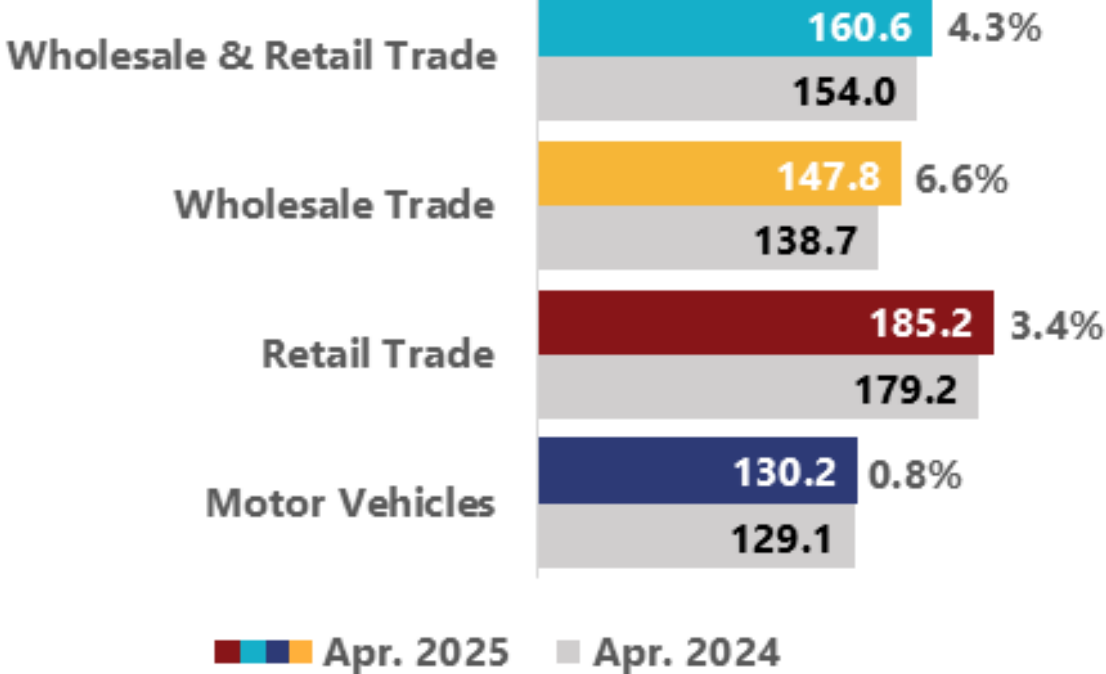

(RM billion)

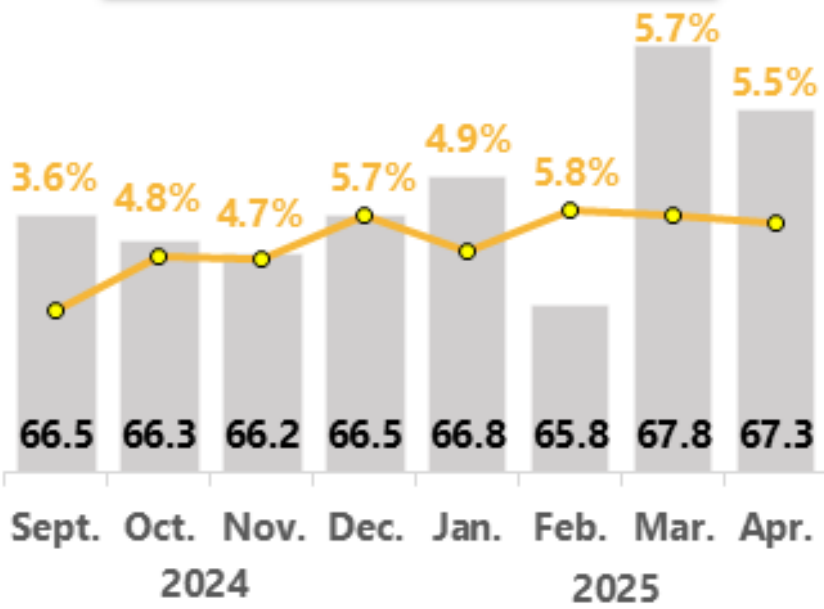


Volume Index

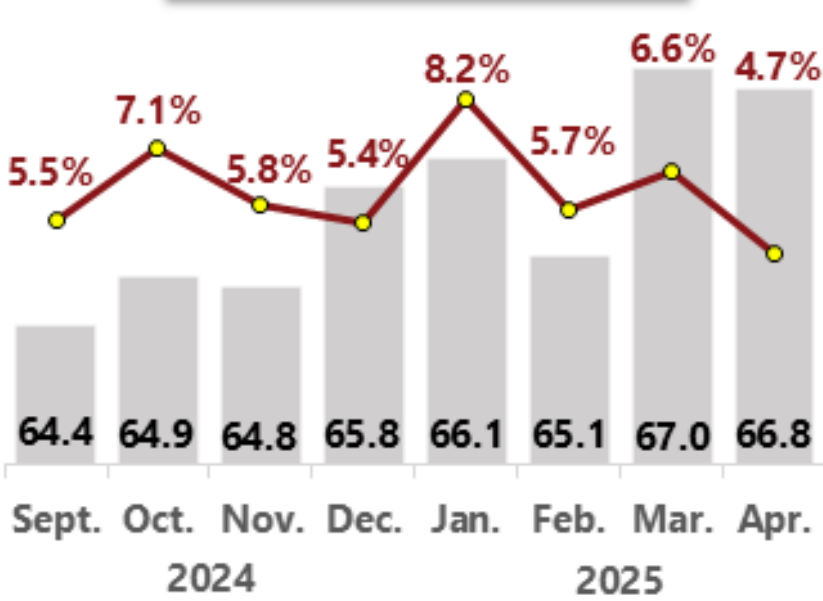


Seasonally Adjusted Volume Index April 2025: -0.3%

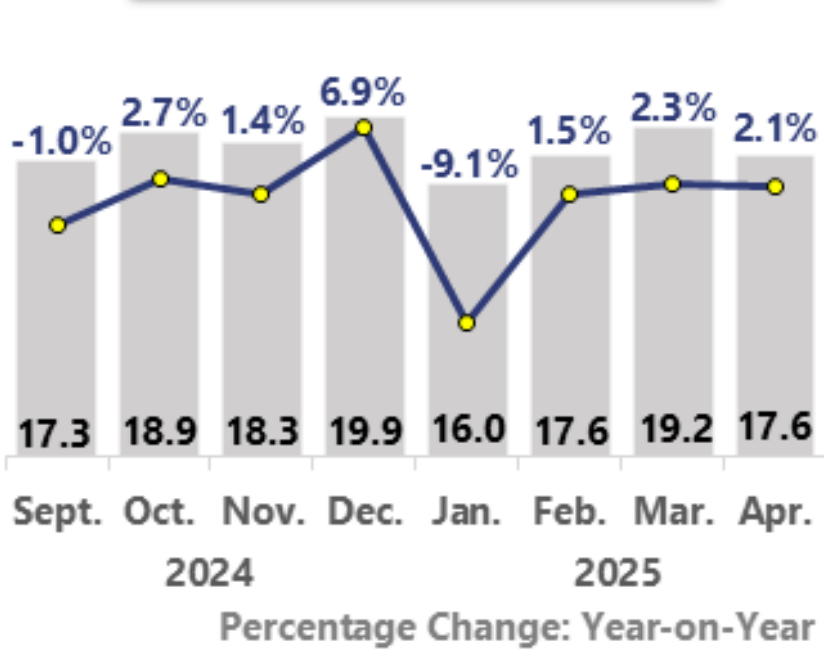
Sales Value of Wholesale Trade

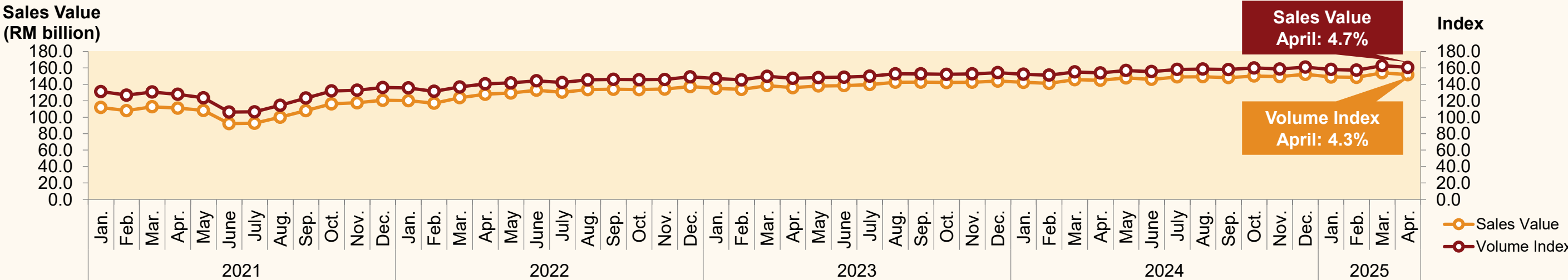

Performance of Sales Value and Volume Index for Wholesale & Retail Trade



Wholesale & retail trade sales reached RM151.7 billion in April 2025, grew 4.7 per cent

- Wholesale & retail trade recorded total sales of RM151.7 billion in April, marking a year-on-year growth of 4.7 per cent.
- Sales growth in April was primarily driven by the Wholesale trade and Retail trade sub-sectors. The Wholesale trade sub-sector registered total sales of RM67.3 billion, marking an increase of RM3.5 billion and a year-on-year growth rate of 5.5 per cent. The Retail trade sub-sector posted a total sales of RM66.8 billion, reflecting a rise of RM3.0 billion and a year-on-year growth of 4.7 per cent. Meanwhile, the Motor vehicles sub-sector recorded sales of RM17.6 billion, representing an increase of RM0.4 billion or 2.1 per cent on a year-on-year basis.
- Wholesale of food, beverages & tobacco rose by 7.5 per cent to RM13.9 billion. Wholesale of household goods also recorded an increase, with a year-on-year growth of 6.6 per cent, reaching RM14.2 billion. Similarly, Other specialised wholesale trade also contributed to the growth of this sub-sector, with a 2.8 per cent increase to RM24.6 billion.
- Retail sales in non-specialised stores increased by 4.2 per cent to RM25.7 billion, while Retail sales in specialised stores grew by 4.5 per cent to RM14.1 billion. Additionally, Retail sales of automotive fuel rose by 5.6 per cent to RM6.2 billion, while Retail sales of information & communication equipment rose by 5.5 per cent to RM5.2 billion. Moreover, Retail sales of household goods expanded by 3.6 per cent to RM7.5 billion.



- Motor vehicles sub-sector recorded an increase in sales compared to April of the previous year, supported by a 13.4 per cent rise in Sales, maintenance & repair of motorcycles, amounting to RM1.1 billion. This was followed by a 2.5 per cent growth in Sales of motor vehicle parts & accessories, reaching RM5.1 billion.
- Online retail sales in April showed an increase, with the index rose by 6.3 per cent year-on-year, driven by festive promotions. However, after seasonal adjustment, the index recorded a month-on-month growth of -1.2 per cent.
- In terms of volume index, Wholesale & retail trade recorded a year-on-year increase of 4.3 per cent. This growth was mainly driven by the Wholesale trade sub-sector, which rose by 6.6 per cent, followed by Retail trade with a 3.4 per cent increase. Meanwhile, the Motor vehicles sub-sector recorded a marginal increase of 0.8 per cent in this month. Conversely, for seasonal adjustment, the volume index posted a month-on-month decrease of -0.3 per cent compared to March 2025.
