




POPULATION PROJECTIONS, MALAYSIA, 2020 - 2060

- Malaysia population is projected at 36.49 million in 2030, 39.78 million (2040), 41.79 million (2050) and 42.37 million (2060).
- The population is expected to continuously increase over the next 40 years and reaching a peak of 42.38 million in 2059 and start to decrease in 2060.
- Malaysia's population growth rate is expected to continue declining throughout the projection period, reaching -0.03 percent by 2060.
- Malaysia is projected to become an ageing nation by 2050.
