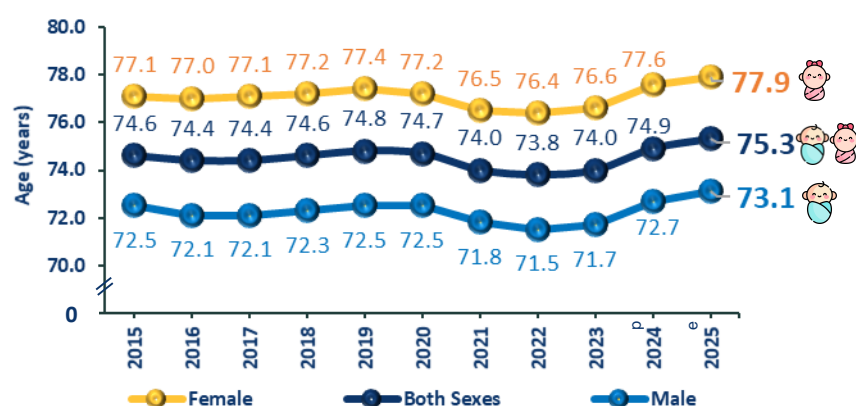

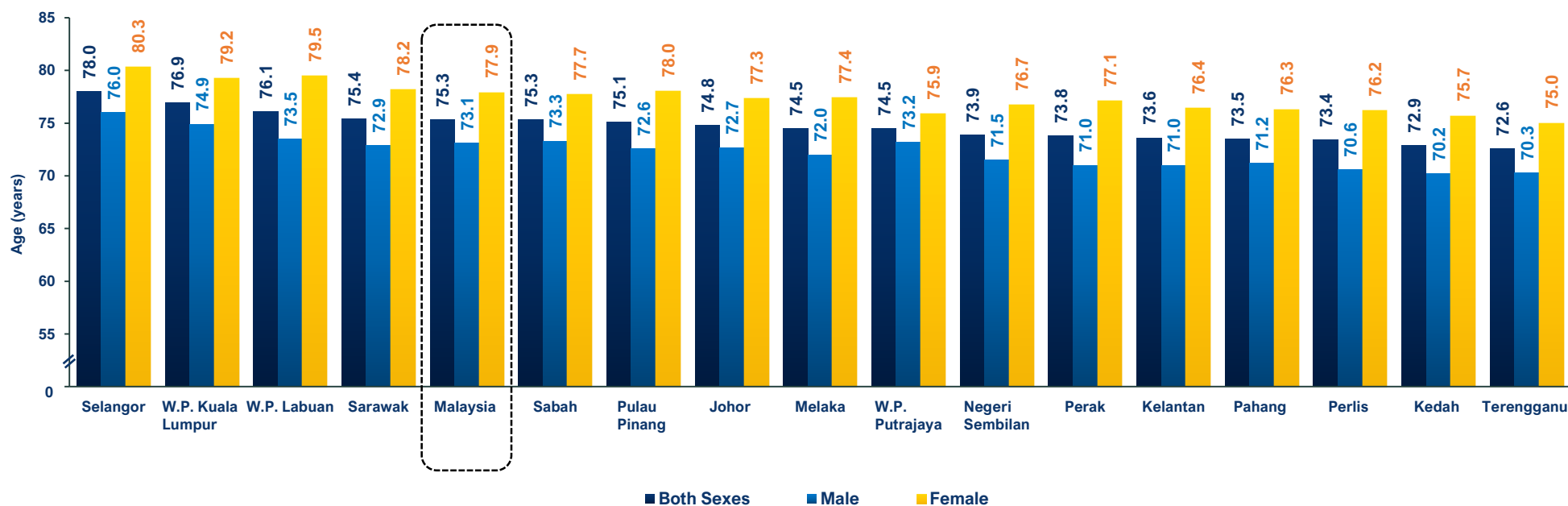

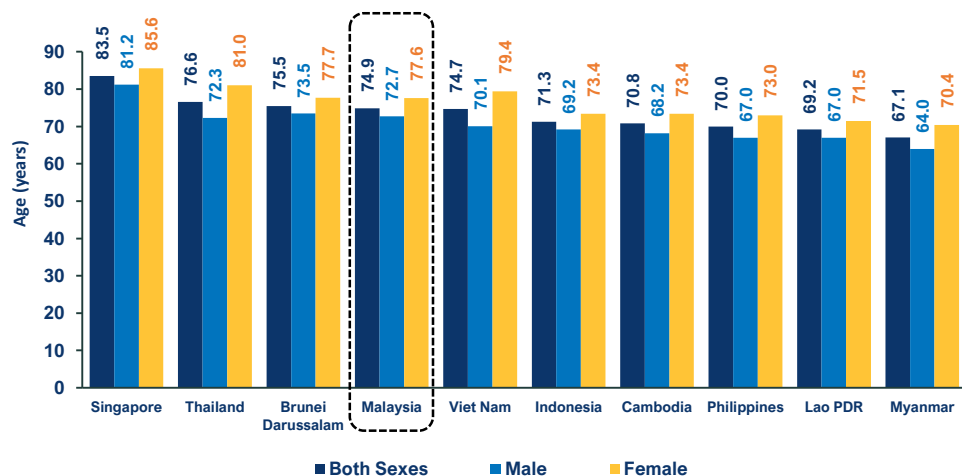

■ Both Sexes ■ Male ■ Female

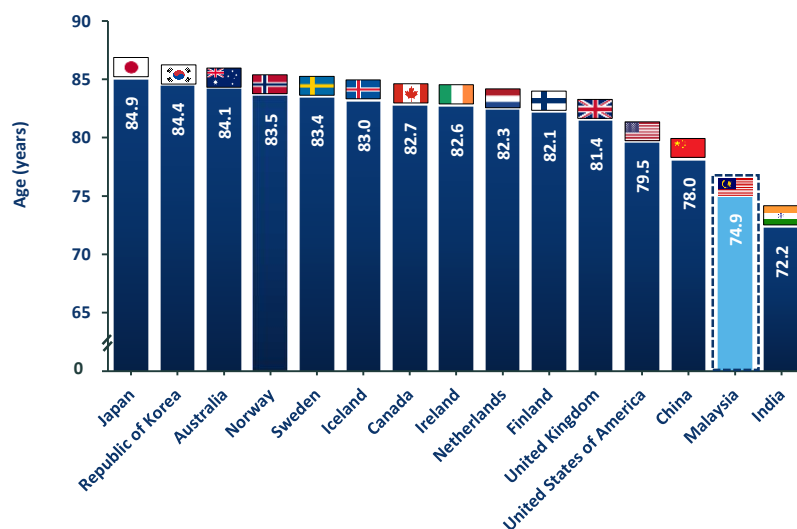
