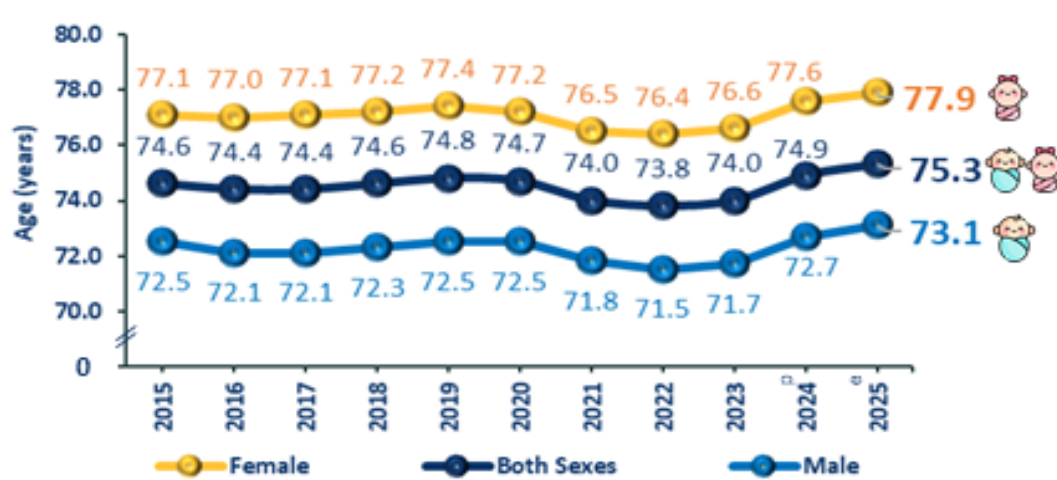

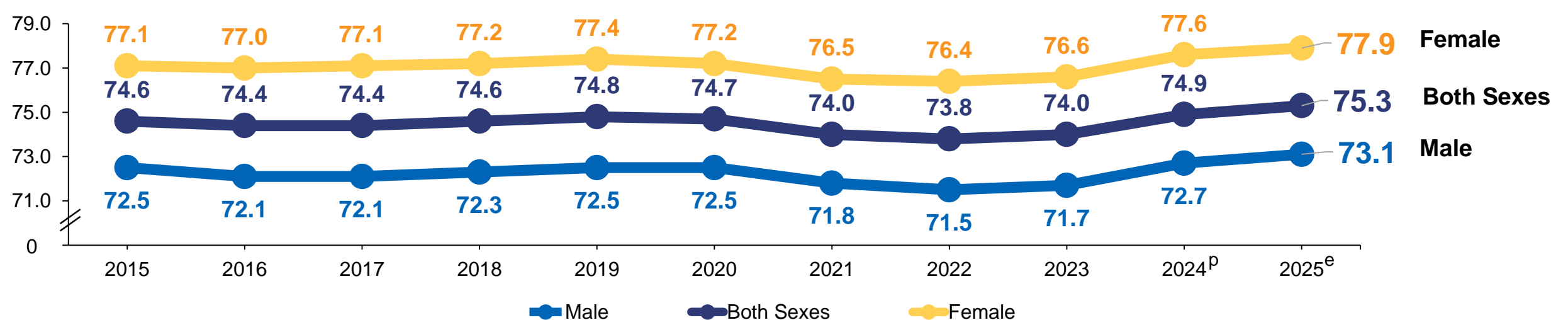

## ***Life Expectancy of the Malaysian Population Continues to Increase in 2025: Babies Born This Year Are Expected to Live for 75.3 Years, with Baby Girls Living 4.8 Years Longer than Boys.***

- A **baby born in 2025** on average is expected to live until **75.3 years**.
- A **baby boy** born in year **2023, 2024 and 2025** on average is expected to live up to **71.7 years, 72.7 years and 73.1 years**, respectively.
- A **baby girl** born in year **2023, 2024 and 2025** on average is expected to live up to **76.6 years, 77.6 years and 77.9 years**, respectively.
- **Males** who reach the age of **15 years in 2025** is expected to live **another 58.8 years**.
- **Females** who reach the age of **15 years in 2025** is expected to live **another 63.6 years**.
- **Males and females** who reach the age of **60 years in 2025** are expected to live for **another 18.8 years and 21.6 years**, respectively. Thus, males aged 60 years in 2024 are expected to live until the age of 78.8 years and females, 81.6 years.
- **Males and females** who reach the age of **65 years in 2025** are expected to live for **another 15.3 years and 17.6 years**, respectively. Thus, males aged 65 years in 2024 are expected to live until the age of 80.3 years and females, 82.6 years.
- **Chinese** remains having the **highest life expectancy at birth** for 2023 to 2025.
- **Selangor** recorded the **highest** life expectancy at birth for **2023 to 2025** while **Terengganu** recorded the **lowest** life expectancy at birth for **the same period**.
- **Samarahan, Sarawak** recorded the **highest** life expectancy at birth for **2023 (79.8 years), 2024 (80.4 years) and 2025 (80.9 years)**. Meanwhile, the lowest life expectancy at birth was recorded in **Kecil Lojing, Kelantan** for **2023 (63.6 years)**, in **Kuala Penyu, Sabah** for **2024 (66.5 years)** and in **Kanowit, Sarawak** for **2025 (66.5 years)**.
